Rules: Prince William Horse Association, Four Winds Farm, Staff and Volunteers will not be held responsible for accident, loss, injuries to exhibitors, spectators, or animals, or damage to equipment of any kind.

- Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-7 pts., 2nd-5 pts., 3rd-4 pts., 4th-3 pts., 5th-2 pts., 6th-1 pt.
- Riders must show in 3 of the 7 shows to be eligible for year end awards.
- Dress is casual. (Boots and breeches, polo shirt)
 and neat, clean clothing. NO halter tops or
 spaghetti strap shirts! Appropriate heeled boots
 and helmets are required.
- No poor sportsmanship or bad conduct will be tolerated by any participant or spectator
- Un judged rounds will be allowed at the regular entry fee.
- PWHA is following USEF rules
- Show management has the right to combine or cancel any classes/divisions if there are less than 3 entries
- Age of rider is determined "as of" January 1, 2012
- The judge has the authority to excuse any horse from a class due to lameness or safety concerns.
- The Judges and/or Show Managers decision is FINAL.
- The use of any illegal equipment (bits, tack, etc.) will be grounds for DO
- If a rider falls from their horse while in the ring, they MUST exit ring before mounting again

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, parent, or trainer to enter riders and horses only in a division in which they can compete safely! If a rider or horse is deemed unsafe they will be pulled from the class/division and ribbons/points will be removed.

All *Hunter* and *Pleasure* classes are judged on the horse's or pony's performance, manners, way of going, soundness and suitability. Points are awarded to the horse/rider combination. A rider may enter more than once as long as they are riding a different horse.

All *Equitation* classes are judged on the rider's hands, seat, guidance and control.

ALL riders must wear a properly secured SEI certified helmet while mounted!

Note-"Go As You Please" requires that you choose one gait (Trot or canter) and perform it in both directions of the ring when called by the judge.

Hunter In Hand: The handler is judged on their ability to present the horse using a pattern. Open Class. Handler may only show one horse.

Lead Line: For riders 7yrs and under. Judged on their basic position in the saddle.

Open Walk/Trot: open to all riders, walk/ trot only. Short Stirrup: For riders 12 and under. Walk and Trot only.

Childrens Division: riders 17 and under. Walk, Trot and Canter. Jumps at 2' or 2'6"

Adult- Division: For riders 18 years and over. Jumps at 2' or 2'6"

Working Hunter: Open division jumps 3' or 3'6" Jack Benny Division- For riders 39+ only. Walk, trot and allowed to canter and get creative in the "Do As You Please" class must remain facing forward with at least one hand on reins.. Points do not count toward overall awards, this division has its own year end award

Novice Horse: For horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Allowed to canter in the Go As You Please class.

Novice Rider: For riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Allowed to canter in the Go As You Please class.

Command Break & Out: Riders must be able to walk, jog, lope, hand gallop, counter canter & drop stirrups if asked. Points count toward year end rider/horse award Open class.
