

Rules: Prince William Horse Association, Four Winds Farm, Staff and Volunteers will not be held responsible for accident, loss, injuries to exhibitors, spectators, or animals, or damage to equipment of any kind.

* Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-7 pts., 2nd- 5 pts., 3rd- 4 pts., 4th- 3 pts., 5th- 2 pts., 6th- 1 pt.

* Riders must show in 3 of the 7 shows to be eligible for year end awards.

* Dress is casual. The requirements are a boot with a heel, a belt, a hat (**SEI certified helmet for anyone under 18 for speed/games classes**) and neat, clean clothing. Sleeveless shirts are allowed but NO halter tops or spaghetti strap shirts! It is entirely up to the individual whether you wear “fancy” western clothes or not.

* No poor sportsmanship or bad conduct will be tolerated by any participant or spectator

* PWHA is following AQHA rules

* The use of any illegal equipment (bits, tack, etc) will be grounds for DQ.

* The judge has the authority to excuse any horse from a class due to lameness or safety concerns.

* The Judge’s and/or Show Manager’s decision is FINAL

* Show management has the right to combine or cancel classes/divisions with less than 3 entries.

* Age of rider is determined “as of” Jan 1, 2011

* Un judged Rides allowed at regular entry fee

* **Games classes are open to any discipline!**

English or western tack is allowed

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, parent, or trainer to enter riders and horses only in a division in which they can compete safely! If a rider or horse is deemed unsafe they will be pulled from the class/division and ribbons/points will be removed.

Note- "Go As You Please" requires that you choose one gait (jog or lope) and perform it in both directions of the ring when called by the judge.

Showmanship: The handler is judged on their ability to present the horse using a pattern. Open class

Lead Line: For riders 7 yrs and under. Judged on their basic position in the saddle.

Walk/ Jog 10 & under: For riders 10 years old and under. Walk and Jog only. Can cross enter into Open classes only

Walk/ Jog Open: Open to all. Walk/jog only

Adult Division: For riders 18 years and over. Walk Jog and Lope. Can cross enter into Open classes only

Junior Division: For riders 11-17 years old. Walk Jog and Lope Can cross enter into Open classes only

Novice Horse: For horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Allowed to lope in the "Go As You Please" class. Can cross enter into Open classes only

Novice Rider: For riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Allowed to lope in the "Go As You Please" class. Can cross enter into Open classes only

Jack Benny Division: For riders 39+ walk/jog . Allowed to lope and get creative in the "Do As You Please" class. Points **do not** count toward overall awards, this division has its own year end award.

Trail: This is an open class. Riders must ride/lead a posted pattern. Points count toward year end rider/horse award. Horse/rider combination must choose one trail class to enter

Working Ranch Horse: See full class description at entry desk.

Command Break & Out: Riders must be able to walk, jog, lope, hand gallop, counter canter & drop stirrups if asked. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Bareback Ride A Buck: Place a dollar bill under your thigh and ride on command without losing the dollar Last one with dollar wins.

Saddled Ride A Buck: Same as above with saddle

Egg & Spoon Race: Ride on command with an egg on a spoon without dropping egg. Last one to drop egg wins.

Ribbon Pairs: Partners must hold crepe paper ribbon between them and ride on command without breaking ribbon.

Musical Sacks: When Music stops riders dismount and run to and stand on a sack while holding horse. Person without sack is out.

Sack Race: Partners start at one end of ring with one leg each in a sack between them. Run to other end, leading ONE horse, step out of sack, one partner helps the other one mount and rider races home

Plug Barrel: Run posted pattern for fastest time. (One barrel up and back) Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Flags: Prescribed pattern for fastest time. Rider can start on either side. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Poles: Prescribed pattern for fastest time. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Barrels: Prescribed pattern for fastest time. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.
