

Prince William Horse Association 2016 Horse Shows

Rules: Prince William Horse Association, Four Winds Farm, Staff and Volunteers will not be held responsible for accident, loss, injuries to exhibitors, spectators or animals, or damage to equipment of any kind.

- Points will be awarded as follows: 1st-7 pts., 2nd- 5 pts., 3rd- 4 pts., 4th- 3 pts., 5th- 2 pts., 6th- 1 pt.
- **Riders must show in 3 of the 7 shows to be eligible for year end awards.**
- English- Dress is casual. (Boots and breeches, polo shirt) and neat, clean clothing. **NO** halter tops or spaghetti strap shirts! Appropriate heeled boots and helmets are required.
- Western- Dress is casual. The requirements are boots with a heel, belt, hat or helmet (**SEI certified helmet for anyone under 18 for speed/games classes**) and neat, clean clothing. **NO** halter tops or spaghetti strap shirts! Its entirely up to the individual whether you wear “fancy” western clothes or not.
- No poor sportsmanship or bad conduct will be tolerated by any participant or spectator.
- Un judged rounds will be allowed at regular entry fee.
- Show management has the right to combine or cancel any classes/divisions if there are less than 3 entries.
- Age of rider is determined “as of” January 1, 2016.
- The judge has the authority to excuse any horse from a class due to lameness OR safety concerns.
- The Judges and/or Show Managers decision is **FINAL**.
- The use of any illegal equipment (bits, tack, etc) will be grounds for DQ.
- If a rider falls from their horse while in the ring, they **MUST** exit the ring before mounting again.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor, parent, or trainer to enter riders and horses only in a division in which they can compete safely! If a rider or horse is deemed unsafe they will be pulled from the class/division and ribbons/points will be removed

Hunter In Hand & Grooming And Showmanship: The handler is judged on their ability to present the horse using a pattern. Open class. Handler may only show one horse.

Lead Line: For riders 7yrs and under. Judged on their basic position in the saddle.

Open Walk/ Trot & Open Walk/ Jog: Open division. Walk and trot/jog only.

Short Stirrup & 12 and Under: For riders 12yrs and under. Walk and trot only.

Childrens Divisions: Riders 17yrs and under. Walk/ trot/ canter. Jumps at 2' or 2'6"- Division may be split if enough entries and points will be separate for 2' and 2'6" if split.

Junior Pleasure: For riders 17 and under, Walk/jog/lope

Adult Divisions: for riders 18yrs and over. Walk/ trot/ canter. Jumps at 2' or 2'6".

Adult Pleasure: For riders 18+ Walk/jog/lope

Working Hunter: Open division. Jumps 2'6" or 3'

Jack Benny Division: For riders 39+yrs only. Walk/ trot and allowed to canter in the "Do As You Please" class. Must remain facing forward with at least one hand on the reins. Points do not count toward overall awards, this division has its own award. English or Western tack!

Novice Horse: For horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in any discipline.

Novice Rider: Riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing in any discipline.

Childrens & Adult Equitation: Open Class. Riders will compete over fences. Judge may "call back" the top riders for a hack class to decide placings, may be asked to drop stirrups, sit trot, etc.

Working Ranch Horse: see full class description at entry desk.

Command Break & Out: Open Class. Rider must be able to walk/ jog/ lope/ hand gallop/ counter canter/ drop stirrups/ etc. if asked. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Bareback Ride A Buck: Place a dollar bill under your thigh and ride on command without losing the dollar. Last one with the dollar wins. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Egg & Spoon Race: Ride on command with an egg on a spoon without dropping egg. Last one to drop egg wins. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.

Ribbon Pairs: Partners must hold crepe paper ribbon between them and ride on command without breaking the ribbon. Points count toward year end rider/horse award.
